The final box is labeled summative assessment. This is formal assessment that occurs at the conclusion of the learning process to evaluate student achievement on the learning objectives. Considerations for Measuring Student Learning As you develop methods for assessing your students consider the following: Include indirect and direct assess-

ments as well as formative and summative assessments. Evaluate whether or not the assessment aligns directly with a learning outcome.

These include standards-based projects and assignments that require students to apply their knowledge and skills, such as designing a building or investigating the water quality of a nearby pond; clearly defined rubrics (or criteria) to facilitate a fair and consistent evaluation of student work; and opportunities for students to benefit from the feedback of teachers, peers, and outside experts.

3. Allow for Self-Assessment. Give students an opportunity to assess their own learning and reflect on the progress they are making. They can identify their own gaps in skills or knowledge, revise their work, and set realistic goals. This process also helps students stay motivated and interested in their own learning. 4.

Assessment and evaluation strategies are varied in nature, administered over a period of time and designed to provide opportunities for students to demonstrate the full range of their learning. In addition, teachers will use both their professional judgment and student observations in evaluating specific criteria and achievement. Classroom assessment techniques (CAT) are relatively quick and easy formative evaluation methods that help you check student understanding in "real time". These formative evaluations provide information that can be used to modify/improve course content, adjust teaching methods, and, ultimately improve student learning.

How to Assess Students' Learning and Performance. Learning takes place in students' heads where it is invisible to others. This means that learning must be assessed through performance: what students can do with their learning. Assessing students' performance can involve assessments that are formal or informal, high- or low-stakes, anonymous or public, individual or collective.

Basic in the assessment prices is the purpose of conducting it. The teacher must be
