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Inclusive Education rolled-out throughout Ghana. Ghana's Inclusive Education Policy, together with its comprehensive implementation plan (2015-2019), has introduced Inclusive Education in schools countrywide. The programme has expanded from 29 districts in seven regions in 2011 to 216 districts in all ten regions by 2016.
