Documentation in long-term care has become increasingly complex as the resident's clinical needs and decision making have become more complex, regulations and surveys more stringent, documentation based payment systems implemented, and litigation-legal challenges have increased. 1 Remember, if it isn't documented, it isn't done! Medical record documentation has always been a critical component of the post-acute care environment, for nursing in particular. In skilled resident care, documentation is required to support MDS coding, reimbursement, and the need for skilled services on an inpatient basis. There are other uses for medical record documentation, however, that shouldn't be overlooked.
