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#### Security Classification Guidance v3 Student Guide

The SIPRNET system maintains an audit trail of all users. This includes the identity of all persons accessing or attempting to access the SIPRNET, date and time of logon/logoff, and any noteworthy activities that might indicate an attempt to modify, bypass, or negate security safeguards.

The new guide sets the security requirements for information up to the Secret classification, sets standards for what systems or information can be handled in a virtual environment and what data should be physically separated, and tweaks the impact levels identified under the old Cloud Security Model.

#### Niprnet Security Classification Guide

The Security Classification Guide (SCG) is part of the Program Protection Plan (PPP). It details how information will be classified and marked on an acquisition program. It's the written record of an original classification decision or series of decisions regarding a system, plan, program, or project.
