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As teachers, we know that teaching is, in essence, about helping pupils to learn. Careful thinking about what it is exactly that you want your pupils to learn, and how best to enable your pupils to achieve this through the learning experiences you provide for them, lies at the heart of the planning process.

Go with the learning: the 'flow' of great progress is more important than following a lesson plan. All students must be working harder than the teacher, over time and be able to use the key strategies. Ensure that learning has stuck, through checking that is incisive, systematic and effective. What key strategies can unlock great teaching?

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Why is planning so important for effective teaching ...

Teaching strategies are methods and techniques that a teacher will use to support their pupils or students through the learning process; a teacher will chose the teaching strategy most suitable to the topic being studied, the level of expertise of the learner, and the stage in their learning journey.

Plan and implement well-structured learning and teaching programs or learning sequences that engage learners and promote learning. In order to plan and implement effective lesson sequences it is important to first know your students and how they learn, the content in which to be taught and teaching strategies which will engage students.

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
